

**SCHEDULE**

*(Inserted by Act 14 of 1999)*

*(Section 2)*

1. The anniversary of the birth of the Sovereign or the day of which due public notice shall be given, appointed to be kept as the Sovereign's birthday.
2. The first day of January in each year.
3. St. Patrick's Day being the 17th day of March in each year.
4. Good Friday.
5. Easter Monday.
6. Labour Monday (the first Monday in May).
7. Whit Monday.
8. The first Monday in August.
9. Christmas Day.
10. Boxing Day.

NOTE: Sundays are observed as Common Law Holidays.

If any public holiday set out above falls on a Saturday or Sunday then the next following Monday shall be a public holiday.

If two public holidays fall on a Saturday and on the next following Sunday, the next following Monday and Tuesday, shall be public holidays.

If two public holidays fall on the same day, the next following day other than a Saturday or Sunday shall be a public holiday.
